Patient Protocol for Performing a Glucose Curve In Pets With Diabetes Mellitus.

Glucose Curves are performed to either determine the starting dose of insulin or for periodic monitoring of glucose levels and insulin performance in our diabetic pets. These are general guidelines and are not designed to supercede any direct request by the doctors.

1. Feed normally in the morning.
2. Water is just fine.
3. Do Not Give Insulin.
4. Please have your pet here by 8 AM. This series of tests lasts all day. If we cannot start on time in the morning, then we may not be able to complete the entire series thereby leading us to potentially erroneous results.
5. You will need to bring your pets' insulin and syringe.
6. We will perform the initial blood glucose test at 8 AM. After the results are obtained we will administer the insulin in accordance with the attending veterinarians orders.
7. Multiple blood samples will be obtained throughout the day.
8. You may pick your pet up between 5 & 5:30 PM.
