Preparation Guidelines For Anesthetic, Surgical, Dental, or Radiographic Procedures

If your pet is scheduled for any anesthetic, surgical, dental, or radiographic procedure there are certain requirements that must be accomplished prior to the event in order to help ensure a positive outcome.

1. Withhold food starting at 6pm the night before.
2. Pick up the water bowl first thing the morning of the procedure.
3. Please have your pet here and checked in before 9 am. We use the time prior to performing the procedure to calm & acclimate the pet, perform preanesthetic examinations and lab work, and administer any preanesthetic sedatives/pain relievers prior to the scheduled procedure time.
4. For dogs, please allow time in the morning for them to eliminate before arrival. For some procedures it is vital for them to have an empty bladder.
5. The exact timing of the performance of the procedure is dictated by the type of procedure being performed, the expected discharge time/date, and the time of arrival at the clinic.
6. You will be notified by phone once your pet is awake and stable.
